

WORLD HYPERTENSION LEAGUE ART COMPETITION

WORLD HYPERTENSION DAY 2020

Young people (under 18 years old) from around the world are invited to submit an art contribution depicting an aspect of high blood pressure for the 2020 World Hypertension Day. Examples of contributions include blood pressure measurement, stroke and cardiovascular disease prevention, healthy lifestyle including increasing physical activity and appropriate weight reduction, and healthy diets including salt reduction.

The suggested art medium is hand drawn posters. Art contributions should be original work displayed on paper sizes between 8"X12" and 21"X36". The artwork should be titled "World Hypertension Day 2020" in the artist's home language. The artists will be recognized with award certificates by the World Hypertension with displays on the websites and scientific meetings and select pieces presented in the WHL Newsletter and World Health Organization. Art should be submitted through a World Hypertension League sponsor which includes the members of the WHL Board, Envoys, Member Societies and partners. Submissions should include:

- > PDF or JPEG of the artwork
- Photo of artist (optional)
- > Name, age, and country of the artist
- > Name and e-mail of sponsor
- >> Statement from parent/guardian and sponsor providing permission for artwork and artists to be displayed by the World Hypertension League.
